



MONITORING AND DETECTION OF ECOSYSTEMS CHANGES FOR ENHANCING RESILIENCE AND ADAPTATION IN THE PHILIPPINES (MODECERA)

- MODECERA, as it is popularly known, is a program led by the University of the Philippines Los Baños (UPLB) and is funded by the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) and Philippine Council for Agriculture, Aquatic and Natural Resources Research and Development (PCAARRD).
- Its main objective is to set up a long-term ecosystems changes monitoring system in eight (8) selected watersheds including the CALSANAG WFR in Tablas, Romblon spearheaded by Romblon State University.

MONITORING AND DETECTION OF ECOSYSTEMS CHANGES FOR ENHANCING RESILIENCE AND ADAPTATION IN THE PHILIPPINES (MODECERA)

HIGHLIGHTS



- **Tablas Drongo (Dicrurus menagei)**, an endemic species to Tablas Island in Romblon, is considered endangered due to its very small population (del Hoyo et al., 2009). Last sighted in 1998, this species is believed to be already extinct until it was spotted by a foreign scientist named Desmond Allen during one of his visits on the island between 1998 and 2002 (Allen, 2006).
- Nearly a decade later, Tablas Drongo is documented for the first time by the MODECERA team in Romblon State University. During fauna assessments conducted in the CALSANAG Watershed Forest Reserve, the team sighted the Dicrurus menagei in Brgy. Balogo in Calatrava, Brgy. Mari-Norte in San Andres, and Brgy. Dubduban in San Agustin.

HIGHLIGHTS



Newly recorded species and newly discovered species. (A) Thomisus sp. and (B) Thomisus guangxicus are the new Philippine recorded species. (C) Orphnaecus n.sp. and (D) Poltys n. sp. are both new Philippine discovered species.

From the collected spiders identified in the watershed, it was found out that *Thomisus sp* and *Thomisus* guangxicus are both new Philippine recorded species.

 While Orphnaecus n. sp. and Poltys n. sp are the new discovered species in the Philippines

ASSESSMENT AND MAPPING OF CORAL REEFS FOR POTENTIAL ECOTOURISM AND LIVELIHOOD OPPORTUNITIES

 Despite the rich marine resources of the province, the coral reef in entire Romblon is not fully assessed as well as their potential as the source of livelihood as a tourism site. In addition, detailed map of coral reef distribution in the province is not yet established. Hence, this project was realized funded by the DENR-Romblon.
